Staff: CAP is happy to announce that Christina Chiappine is our new Client Service Coordinator. As a member of AmeriCorps, Christina worked zealously for CAP and made a remarkable contribution to the mission of this agency. Christina has now graduated from AmeriCorps and will stay with CAP to fill our staff position. She will manage our crisis alleviation programs and will strive to help our clients become more self-sustaining. Mary Jane Simmons continues her work with CAP in the role of chief volunteer.

Crisis Alleviation: For the fiscal year ended 6/30/05, CAP distributed \$23,480 in crisis alleviation funds, serving 111 households. The food closet served an average of 70 households per month, representing an average of 180 individuals per month.

Thrift Shop Donations: We have run out of space to store winter clothing - please bring this to us in November. Items now in demand: Jewelry, knick knacks, wall hangings, figurines, toys, lamps, small appliances, cookware, scarves, fashion hats, sheets, towels, curtains. Call Mary Jane at 428-1247 if you need us to pick up donations at your home.

Food Closet Donations: We continue to be gratified by the generous donations of non-perishables made to CAP's food closet. CAP also is a welcoming home for the overflow from your vegetable garden. **Attention travelers:** Bring us those pesky little bottles of shampoo and lotion that you have collected from your hotel stays.

Financial Highlights: For the fiscal year ended 6/30/05, CAP's income included, among other items, \$6,306 church donations, \$6,131 gross revenue from the thrift shop, \$1,366 net profit from the Strawberry Festival.
