

Update from Richardson Park Community Action Program January 13, 2006

Food Closet: From July 1 to December 31, 2005, CAP's food closet served 324 households, representing 475 adults and 325 children. In addition, CAP provided twenty-five special Christmas food baskets to needy families in our service area.

Crisis Alleviation: We thank the Woodcrest Civic Association for its grant of \$500, to be used for heating oil and natural gas for our clients. This gift has been added to the amount already in CAP's budget for these necessities. The price of heating oil and natural gas has jumped by about 45 percent over the last twelve months. This price increase has created a financial crisis for many of our neighbors. The food closet helps to fill out strained budgets.

On Saturday evening, we went to the final session of the day, where we saw for the second time our Youth Group's favorite band - Starfield. They were a very powerful band and even led us in an old hymn in a bluegrass/mountain music style. Chris Tomlin (my favorite) performed that evening, and we heard a very powerful message from Stacey Brooks. Michelle Anderson and the Gibbons' girls particularly enjoyed George Hutt - an American Idol finalist. The evening wrapped up with devotions led beautifully by Katie Chambers.

The next morning, we prepared for our final session - it was very powerful!!! We heard JME Medina perform pop/Latin songs. She also told an encouraging story that reminded us that the LORD can right even our biggest mistakes and reminded us of His amazing, perfect Love for us. The girls from our group were also able to have their T-shirts signed by Starfield. Kayla Brown and the Anderson girls were particularly excited because they were one of the last people to have their shirts signed before the band had to leave - leaving the rest of the crowd without their autographs.
