If we ever need to develop a renewable energy source to help with the church's utility bills, I have one that lives with me. He's amazing.

While the kids were busy being kids and adults were busy being Grumpy (he's the sixth dwarf in case you wondered), I was able to spend some time reflecting on the theology of Disney. (I know that sounds a bit dull, but it's what we pastors do when we are out and about.) In their shows and attractions, Disney spends a lot of time talking about

the power of dreams and imagination. I believe that this is a very good thing. We don't do enough of that in church or in mainstream society. However, Disney doesn't do a good job of connecting imagination or dreams to their ultimate source, God, which leaves me feeling like they are peddling an empty promise. For example, during the big fireworks display on New Year's Eve, right before the grand finale, they played the song Let There Be Peace on Earth (and Let It Begin with Me). It was such a beautiful vision that it almost brought me to tears. Unfortunately, without God at the center of that vision, I don't believe that peace is possible. We are just not capable of it. (Even with God at the center, it has still been a big challenge.) Disney invites us to seek the good in life without the connection to Jesus who makes it all possible. Corruptible humanity cannot do this on its own. We need Jesus!

So, my friends, keep on dreaming. Keep on dreaming of a world that is Christ centered and Kingdom filled. Keep dreaming of a world of peace and justice and love and hope and joy and, through those dreams and your imagination, God can change the world through us.
