Imagine, if you will, a child getting off a school bus and not knowing where they will lay their head at night. Imagine a parent going to work every day but their income isn't sufficient to cover unexpected expenses. Maybe they have to choose between paying their rent or repairing their car so they can continue to make it to work. Imagine parents losing their jobs and finding themselves in the predicament of trying to find a shelter which allows them to stay together until they can get on their feet. A person experiencing homelessness isn't always the stereotype we perceive them to be.

We often picture the homeless as people who have no shelter and walk the streets or sleep in the park. We think of them as that person holding up a sign that says, "Will work for food." Sadly, in the State of Delaware, one of every five people experiencing homelessness is a child.

We, the family and friends of Richardson Park UMC, have an opportunity to shine the light of Christ through the ministry of *Family Promise*. Family Promise provides

opportunities for faith communities to put their faith into action. Serving is not limited to any age. You can serve as a group or individuals.

In the early spring, Family Promise is opening a new facility which will provide an opportunity to churches who are unable to host families in their buildings to get involved. The new model will happen at a centrally located facility. Churches who are not currently involved are being asked to make this new adventure a success.

The Missions Committee and I are looking for volunteers who are willing to give a few hours for one week every three months to help four-five families experiencing homelessness. The families have participated in background checks prior to being accepted in the Family Promise program. These families have the potential to be back on their feet within months.

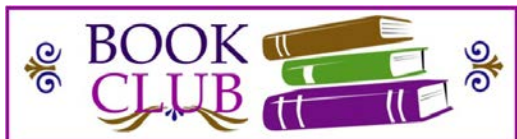

February 2018 Tech Tip

Happy New Year everyone. Its time again to get ready for a new round of the old scams. This month's article will look at two popular methods to scam you out of your savings.

First is the windows tech support scam. I personally have received at least 4 of these this month. The caller claims to be representing Microsoft support and that they have detected a problem with your computer. The scammer is attempting to get you to allow them to have remote access to your computer to "fix" the problem. Once connected, the scammer is able to download malicious software which can track your keystrokes and allow the capture of personal information. In addition, the scammer will charge for the service by asking for credit card payment of an outrageous fee. The next part of the scam is identity theft since they now have your name, address and credit card information. Remember, you should NEVER give out your credit card information over the phone to an unsolicited caller.

The second scam to look out for is scammers attempting to get your Social Security Number. I have read that, starting in April of this year, Medicare will be sending out new Medicare

cards with a random ID instead of your social security number. Any time there is a change which may create uncertainty, scammers will try to use that to their advantage. Don't be surprised if there are a new set of scams to try to get you to reveal your name and SSN. An important fact to remember is it is rarely necessary to give out your Social Security Number. If asked to do so, challenge the requester and insist on justification.

Have an enjoyable year and remember your personal information is the same as cash. Protect it like you would your money. Never trust an unsolicited phone caller or sales person. Challenge all strangers coming to your door and always verify their identity.
