

HOW DO YOUR GIFTS SUPPORT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS AROUND THE WORLD?




THE CHILDREN'S CORNER


Each church will have a table for their information. There will be food, music, games and lots of fun!! Come on out to Family Fun Day!



TECHNOLOGY TIPS

This is a nifty tip I found on poworld's web site.

Windows 10 has an integrated emoji keyboard which allows you to select a telephone style emoji, an ASCII emoji or a special character.

To summon it, simply press the Windows key and; (semi colon) simultaneously on your keyboard to get the emoji popup.

Another little trick is a way to insert an ASCII character. If you happened to see the movie "The Martian" you may remember Matt Damon looking for an ASCII table. This trick works for numbers from 001 to 255. Hold down the ALT key and using a numeric keypad type simultaneously type a number from 001 to 255 then release the ALT key. For example ALT 125 generates }. This only works with a numeric keypad.


