

Dear Lord, help me to see, know and thank you for the countless beautiful and wonderful things in our lives.



TECHNOLOGY TIPS BY JIM CHILCUTT

Word Shortcut Quick Tips

- 1.Use the Search Box to Find Features a. Ctrl-Q
- 2. Highlight a Sentence With a Click
- a. Cursor at begin of sentence, press Ctrl for rest of sentence.
- 3. Select Text From the Keyboard
- a. Place cursor where selection starts, press F8 to select a word F8 to select the line and again to select a paragraph.
- 4. Jump to Your Most Recent Edits
- a. From anywhere on the page press Shift F5 to jump to the location of the last edit.
- 5. Change Capitalizations the Easy Way
- a. Do you want to capitalize every word in a header, or reduce all-caps text to lowercase? Select the text you want to change, then press Shift-F3 repeatedly until the text looks the way you want.
- 6. Switch between open windows.
- a. Alt Tab and select the desired window.
- 7. Stop word from inserting automatic underline.
- a. If you type three or more hyphens on a separate line, Word will insert a horizontal line across the page. Click on the paragraph with the line below it. Go to the Home tab, and, in the Paragraph box, find the Borders icon, which looks like a four-cell table. Select the icon with no borders and click on it. The line will go away.
- 8. Use the Keyboard for Almost Anything
- a. Press the Alt key and word will highlight all the shortcuts.

The Al-Anon Family Groups are a fellowship of relative and friends of alcoholics who share experience, strength and hope in order to solve their common problems.




